The 4-Phases of a Disaster:

- 1) Preparedness: (pets and people).
- 2) Mitigation: (fire prevention and home hardening).
- 3) Response: (evacuation planning and Genasys Protect Evac Map).
- 4) Recovery: (local assistance centers and the recovery process).
